- 2. **Assignment B: Vehicle Component Familiarization Video:** Working with your parent and or legal guardian, submit a familiarization video of you (the student) locating and identifying while briefly detailing out the purpose of the following vehicle components, please refer to lesson three of your course work for additional resources.

# a. Comfort & Information system

i. Seats, headrests, Dashboard, Air Conditioner, heater & Air vents.

## b. Control Systems

i. Ignition Switch, Selector Level for Automatic Transmission, Gear shift for manual transmission, Clutch Pedal, Steering wheel, Accelerator or Gas Pedal, Cruise Control, Brake Pedal and Parking brake

### c. Visibility Systems

i. Lights(turn signals, headlights, taillights, brake lights, reverse lights, and emergency flashers), Windshield Wiper/Washer, Sun Visor, Defroster, Rear, and side-view mirrors.

### d. Protective Systems

i. Safety Belts, Air Bags, Head Restraints, Door locks.

### e. Under hood fluid

i. Locate and check the levels of the engine oil, radiator coolant, battery connectors, brakes fluid, Power steering fluid (if applicable), transmission oil (if accessible and windshield washer fluid.
